Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for your continued patience and support during the ever-changing circumstances we're facing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As you are aware, all Pike County schools will be transitioning to the hybrid learning model as indicated in the Yellow/Moderate-Risk Model, beginning Tuesday, September 8, 2020 through Friday, September 25, 2020.

During hybrid learning, your children will attend school in-person two days a week and learn from home the other three days. This reduces the number of students within each building and on buses by half, leaving one full day for the school to remain empty and undergo additional cleaning and sanitizing between groups.

While learning from home, your child will complete work assigned to them after receiving their-person instruction at school. It is likely your child will complete some or all of their work online. They will be permitted to bring their Chromebook home during their remote learning days, and we ask that you contact your building principal if you're concerned about your child's internet access.

Each teacher will have a process for determining daily attendance while students are at home, and it's very important that you are informed and prepared to meet these requirements. Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions or concerns, as due dates and attendance policies will be upheld.

All students have been grouped by family, to attend school and learn from home on the same days as their siblings. Your child or children have been placed in **Group B**.

Group B - In Person, at the school every Thursday and Friday with Remote Learning, At Home every Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday

We are committed to providing you with timely and accurate updates on our public health authorities' best recommendations and guidance. We will continue monitoring the situation weekly and proceed on a week-by-week basis. Your child's teacher will provide additional details about how learning will continue on days your child completes remote learning from home, and you can contact the school for questions pertaining specifically to each building. We also encourage everyone to access the latest, most accurate information about COVID-19 from the Indiana State Department of Health (www.coronavirus.in.gov/) and the CDC (www.cdc.gov/covid-19).
